Tournament Director & Club President, Chuck Wallace, awarded gold, silver, and bronze medals to the top three winners in four afternoon classes, and trophies to the top three winners in four morning classes.

The Tournament Champion Patch was won by Jerry Harley from Chesapeake Bay's Western Shore. The youngest player at 12 years old this year, "G" Class Champ Ray Smith, Jr., was the only youth in the Junior Division competing today. The only undefeated player was Joe Smith in "C" Class, who was also awarded a plaque for the 2008 "Most Improved" of the Men's Division (regular 40 footers).
