With mild temperatures and clear skies, forty five contestants met in the First State Horseshoe Club's third sanctioned Open Tournament of the season. Each of the 27 Delawareans, 10 Marylanders, 7 Pennsylvanians, and one Virginian pitched at least 160 shoes, most of them 240 shoes, while two had to deliver 320 shoes due to 1st place ties. Dan Carter, Tournament Director & Delaware's Regional Director, awarded trophies to the top three winners in six classes, and cash to the top three winners in the "Championship Class".

Cash, plus the Tournament Champion Patch was won by Don Wiley from Jarrettsville, MD, who was the ONLY undefeated player for the day.

The youngest player at 9 years old this year was Eddie Tripp, IV, from Smyrna, who was the 2008 "Cadet" champion.

The oldest player (age not for circulation, lol) was "Elder" Victor Kulmala, from Bear, who won "B" Class.

Joe Michael, from Newark, won TWO awards: 2nd place in "D" Class (losing the tie-breaker to Kermit Greer, from Elkton, MD), plus a plaque for the 2008 "Most Improved Rookie" of the Men's Division (regular 40 footers).

Among the group visiting from Maryland was the President of the Baltimore Metro Horseshoe Club, Terry Hitzelberger.
